National Council Licensure Examination (NCLEX)

This narrative provides an update on the most recent performance of our Class of 2018 School of Nursing graduates on the National Council Licensure Examination for Registered Nurses (NCLEX). The NCLEX exam is a standardized exam that each state board of nursing uses to determine a candidate's readiness for entry-level nursing practice. This period covers one full calendar year.
