








#### **DPT Pass Rates**




## **Nursing Licensure Exam Score Trends**



Baccalaureate programs in Florida experienced a significant decline in 2021

Modest decline observed nationally

#### **NCLEX First-Time Pass Rate Comparison**



Accreditation Commission for Education in Nursing (ACEN) will vote to begin monitoring ultimate pass rates (July vote)

- Will be used in conjunction with the current standard (80% first-time pass rate threshold)

# **Critical Needs - Nursing**



Category	Description					
Student Support	Recruitment scholarships; financial assistance to address unmet need and reduce the need for part-time employmen					
Facilities Upgrades	Modernize building infrastructure; upgrade and expand classroom and experiential learning spaces; identify additional spaces for student study/congregation					
Personnel						
-Nursing Support Faculty	Provide support for pre-nursing courses and activities					
-General Science Faculty	Teach foundational science courses for pre-nursing students					
-Nursing Faculty	Address staffing shortages for BSN and RN-BSN programs					
-Remediation Specialists	Needed to compliment the two existing positions; provides targeted academic support and remediation					
-Operational Support	Provide support for student affairs, administrative offices, and faculty					
-Curriculum Designer	Manage curriculum revisions for traditional and online program; ensure alignment with accreditation and licensure exam requirements

# **Key Updates - Pharmacy**



#### **Accreditation**

- ACPE On-Site Evaluation conducted November 15-17, 2021
- Accreditation extended until June 30, 2024 (shortened term)
  - 3 Standards "Partially Compliant"
    - Standard 23: Financial Resources (College and Provost's Office will address)
    - Standard 24: Assessment and Educational Outcomes (assign additional FTE for assessment)
    - Standard 25: Assessment Structure and Process (assign additional FTE for assessment)

#### **Educational Enhancements to Increase First-Time Pass Rates**

- Revised curriculum in 2017 (new accreditation outcomes)
- Admission requirements and P1 admits exceed GPA thresholds
- Implementation of college-wide remediation plan
- Rx Care Center with PharmD teaching assistants and tutoring learners
- High-stakes examinations
- Use of NAPLEX review courses
