Regulations of Florida A&M University



8.003 Acquisition and Disposal of Motor Vehicles.

- (1) The term "motor vehicles" includes any automobile, watercraft, aircraft, truck or other vehicles designed for transportation of persons, and construction vehicles or farm equipment.
- (2) All motor vehicles shall be procured through the University's Purchasing Department in accordance with University rules, policies and procedures.
- (3) The University has the authority to:
 - (a) Establish standard classes of motor vehicles to be leased, purchased or used by University personnel;
 - (b) Establish and operate facilities for the acquisition, disposal, operation, maintenance, repair, storage, control, and regulation of University-owned motor vehicles. Acquisition may be by purchase, lease, installment-purchase, loan, or by any other legal means and may include a trade-in. All motor vehicles purchased shall be of a class that will safely transport University personnel and adequately meet the requirements of the University;
 - (c) Obtain the most effective and efficient motor vehicles for University purposes.
- (4) Disposal of surplus motor vehicles will be executed in accordance with Florida A & M University Regulation Chapter 9, Surplus Property.
