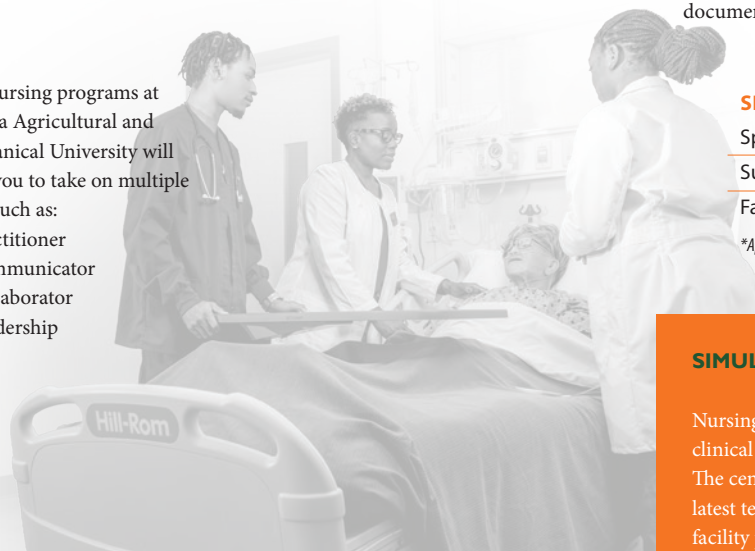
ABOUT THE PROGRAM
