

Values, Principles, and Priorities

Accountability - an obligation or willingness to accept responsibility or to account for one's actions

<u>Inclusion</u> - the act of including; the state of being included; the act or practice of including and accommodating people who have historically been excluded (as because of their race, gender, sexuality, or ability)

Innovation - a new idea, method, or device.

<u>Integrity</u> - firm adherence to a code of especially moral or artistic values; incorruptibility; an unimpaired condition: soundness; the quality or state of being complete or undivided; completeness

Efficiency - the quality or degree of being efficient; capable of producing desired results with little or no waste (as of time or materials)

<u>Objectivity</u> - the quality or character of being objective; lack of favoritism toward one side or another; freedom from bias

Confidentiality - the state of keeping or being kept secret or private

Competency - possession of sufficient knowledge or skill
